- Share via the Power BI Service
- Share via Power BI Desktop

To share a Power BI report via the Power BI Service, simply follow these steps:

- 1. Open the report you want to share.
- 2. Click on the "Share" button in the top right corner of the screen.
- 3. Enter the email addresses of the people you want to share the report with.
- 4. Click on the "Share" button.




